COMPREHENSIVE CONSUMER EDUCATION

Describe how the Coalition coordinated resource and referral programs specifically related to the provision of comprehensive consumer education to parents and the public regarding participation in the school readiness program and parental choice.

The Coalition participated in thirty-two (32) community outreach events to promote and educate the general public on school readiness, voluntary prekindergarten programs and parental choice. In addition, the Coalition hosted community outreach events including an Annual Conference and Storybook Forest for nearly six thousand parents, children, community members, and child care providers.

Through “Circle of Security” the Coalition offered several parent training opportunities on the importance of building relationships that support a child’s security and future success.

The Coalition collaborates with many community agencies to support families and their children in our service areas.

The Early Learning Coalition of Pasco and Hernando Counties, Inc. recognizes the importance of high quality early learning environments. To that end, the Coalition participated in the following financial supports for school readiness providers:

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The Coalition participated in the Early Learning Performance Funding Project supporting twenty five (25) provider. Child care facilities and family child care homes participated in quality improvement strategies that included specialized trainings, professional development, coaching and child assessment implementation. Providers received financial incentives for course completion.

The Coalition gave classroom materials to our forty (40) Sunshine Stars (QRIS) Providers to support their efforts toward continuous quality improvement. We purchased and awarded the materials from specific vendors to help the providers and teachers enhance group time, curriculum, and teacher-child interactions.

The Coalition also offered three (3) scholarships to Family Child Care Home Providers to attend the 29th National Family Child Care Conference. Participants qualified for the scholarship by submitting an essay stating how attending the conference would benefit them professionally. Scholarship winners were reimbursed for qualifying expenses upon submission of certificates of completion and receipts.

- Child Screenings and Assessments

ASQ's A-Z: The ASQ Screeners unlock critical knowledge about a child's development and helps give all kids the best start in life. This tool provides teachers with valuable information to guide their teaching and helps in the early detection of potential developmental delays. It is ESSENTIAL that all early educators know how to accurately complete and understand ASQ's. This training provides all the information needed to know to successfully complete and utilize the ASQ-3 and ASQ-SE2.

Ongoing Assessments: This training is about understanding what progress monitoring looks like in a Pre-K classroom, and how to record anecdotal notes, videos, pictures, checklists and use that information to create an on-line portfolio for each child. By creating portfolios, teachers are able to track the growth and development of each child in their classroom.

We're More Alike than Different: A hands-on disability awareness program designed to increase sensitivity to individuals with disabilities. Participants complete a variety of activities that simulate what it's like to have a visual impairment, autism, intellectual delay, etc.

- Developmentally Appropriate Curricula and Character Development

Early Literacy: Connecting to Your Curriculum: This training guides early educators to create developmentally appropriate and exciting lessons for Language Development and Phonological Awareness. The 7 components of early literacy from Creative Curriculum are reviewed and teachers will experience hands-on opportunities to create their own early literacy activity or game.

Lesson Plans that Shine: Lesson plans are an essential tool in designing high quality learning experiences in early learning. Lesson plans are crucial for staying organized and ensuring class time is used appropriately, and also ensure the appropriate skills are being taught in developmentally appropriate ways that benefit the children in the class. Participants learn how to organize their thoughts, create and develop appropriate goals and objectives and write lesson plans for a high quality preschool program.

You Make the Difference: Understanding Developmental Milestones: Learn the developmental milestones of child development (birth – five) and understand the significance of facilitating a supportive and joyous environment.

Music Does Wonders: This training is for anyone working with children birth through Elementary Age. Participants will learn brain-based research on the use of music and movement in the classroom and developmentally appropriate practice. You will learn how to build your own musical instruments for your classroom and how to integrate music across the entire curriculum. Preschool

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teachers will receive teaching tips and web based resources. Music does wonders for all children including children with special needs.

Stack it Up with Blocks: The Block Center may be the single most useful center in the early-childhood classroom. Learn how to plan exciting play experiences in your block center. Engage young children to develop new concepts when building with blocks. We will look at the developmental stages of block play so we can observe what needs to be available for the children to enhance that stage and encourage them to move to the next stage. We will discuss ways to enhance block play by using accessories that increase what your children are learning.

Inspiring Play with Loose Parts: During this training, early learning educators will discover the foundation for incorporating loose parts into daily lesson activity plans. They will be given opportunities to explore loose parts for themselves. Techniques and strategies will be provided for instructors to enhance play experiences during the preschool day.

Incredible Infants and Terrific Toddlers: Infants and toddlers learn best by touching, smelling, seeing, and tasting the things they find in their environment. They are explorers because the world is new to them. In this training participants will learn how to involve children in experiences that directly support their emerging awareness of others, emergent language, motor skills, and social/emotional development.

Terrific Transitions: It is amazing how well your day can flow in your classroom when transitions are handled appropriately. Transitional songs and activities are powerful tools. They guide children through the day, help groups move from one area to another smoothly, and gives each child positive interaction with their caregivers. This interactive class will provide teachers with rhymes, songs and creative fun activities to help transitions flow smoothly.

Professionalism in the Childcare Setting: In this training, one will focus on integrating high quality standards and practices into the development, implementation, and management of programs serving young children and their families. Learners will demonstrate commitment to acquiring and maintaining current professional knowledge and on-going professional development. Learners will be able to advocate high quality early childhood care and education programs that serve young children and their families and define ethics within a childcare profession.

Supporting Early Social and Emotional Development in Infants, Toddlers and Twos: What do you think of when someone says social and emotional development in infants and toddlers? Do you ever wonder why toddlers won't share? Or, why some children bite? Or, why some babies are "easy" to care for while others are "fussy"? This interactive session focuses on the formation of these developing skills and how you can support the children in your care.

Adapting Classroom Activities and Materials for Young Children with Special Needs: Part of the challenge of teaching young children is managing the wide variety of students and their capabilities. For instance, a child who has difficulty controlling

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his emotions needs an entirely different approach to education than a child that is nonverbal. This training is designed to provide you with simple adaptations you can make to the learning environment, the daily routines, the classroom materials, and the way you provide instruction for children from birth through age 5.

It's More than Counting: Exploring Mathematical Concepts with Infants and

Toddlers: For some, math seems like nothing more than a subject taught in elementary school and beyond but the foundation for learning math operations begins at birth! For even the youngest child, math exploration is an important part of their play. Not only does it build their understanding of how the world around them works, it also allows them to see how elements in their environment are connected. Join us to discover how adding some simple experiences and intentionally using math vocabulary is an easy way to enhance mathematical understanding for infants and toddlers.

Enjoy the Process: Art Experiences that Promote Creativity and Problem-

Solving: Children are naturally curious. From the moment they gain some control over their bodies, they begin to explore their world to see how it works. They watch, explore, and engage with it, trying to figure out what impact they can have upon their environment. Child-directed art exploration naturally supports these efforts. When we offer young children the freedom to manipulate different materials in an organic and unstructured way, these budding artists learn to practice a wide range of skills. Skills that are useful not only for life, but also for learning.

Mix It Up! Physical Well-being in the Preschool Classroom: Healthy lifestyle attitudes begin at birth! And, as an early childhood educator, (and the person who spends a large portion of each day with the children) you play a crucial role in the development of their views on physical well-being. Preschool children are forming opinions on how much and what to eat as well as when to stop eating.

Do you Have It? Understanding Child Development from Birth to Age 3: Healthy lifestyle attitudes begin at birth! And, as an early childhood educator, (and the person who spends a large portion of each day with the children) you play a crucial role in the development of their views on physical well-being.

Discover the Wonder of Anna Dewdney's Llama Llama Books: Discover the wonder in Anna Dewdney's Llama Llama books that inspire children with a fun literacy twist. Learn new techniques to encourage empathy through play and new activity ideas.

Core Competencies for Practitioners, Core Competencies for Directors AND Core Competencies for Aftercare: Our Senior Training Specialist is OEL certified to conduct all sessions of the Florida Core Competency Trainings for Early Learning Practitioners.

The Value of Play in Early Literacy Development: Research demonstrates that the role of play is crucial in early childhood development and when acquiring early literacy skills. Learn how you can utilize play in the classroom to promote early literacy development through this interactive workshop.

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How to Incorporate Math in Everyday Play: Children's language and understanding develop together; math reasoning is no different. Learn how to facilitate the language of math in everyday play and activities to build children's capacity for mathematics.

Awesome Alphabet Activities: This interactive session will provide participants with engaging strategies that make learning the alphabet meaningful to young children. Activities that promote the recognition and naming of letters will be demonstrated and practiced. Come join us as we learn new activities that you can use in your classroom the very next day.

Early Literacy: Reading Through Recyclables: Explore creative and innovative ways to inspire preschool students to enjoy reading. We will re-use recyclable materials in ways to teach letter recognition, letter sounds, and early literacy, all while making it fun and cost effective.

- Teacher-Child Interactions

MMCI Pre-K: During the 2018-2019 fiscal year, the coalition had three MMCI certified trainers and offered 5 cohorts of MMCI for Pre-K Teachers.

MMCI Infant/Toddler: During the 2017-18 fiscal year, the coalition had three MMCI certified trainers and offered 4 cohorts of MMCI for Infant Toddler Teachers.

Circle of Security: At times all parents and caregivers feel lost or without a clue about what children might need from us. Imagine what it might feel like if you were able to make sense of what your children were really asking from you. The Circle of Security® Parenting™ program is based on decades of research about how secure parent-child and teacher-child relationships can be supported and strengthened.

ACEs and the Power of One: Children who have experienced trauma often demonstrate challenging behaviors that can impact learning. This workshop will explore the ACEs Study and the impact that one positive relationship can have in a child's life and on their future learning and development.

Developing Effective Partnerships Between Parents, Families and Schools to help Save Our Children and Save Our Schools: Learn about the important collaboration between parents and teachers, as well as effective strategies you can use to help children solve life problems successfully. Learn best practices, practical strategies, and successful program models for social-emotional development, school readiness and parent-teacher partnership.

Classroom Interactions that Make a Difference: This interactive workshop will discuss and provide research based methods of meaningful interactions in the classroom as well as exploring why they are so important.

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- Age-Appropriate Discipline Practices

Taking the Sting out of Biting: Biting is an upsetting toddler behavior that can result from feelings of frustration, overstimulation, anger, hunger, and pain related to teething. Join us as we study “interventions” for biting incidents. Participants will discover the seven reasons for chronic biting behavior and design customized solutions to help stop and prevent this phenomenon.

How to Raise a Problem Solver: Children are not born problem solvers; we as adults must train them on this necessary life skill. Encouraging children to think about cause and effect, and how their feelings affect their own behavior can help build problem solving skills. Learn how to hand problems back to children so they may repair relationships and make amends when necessary.

- Health and Safety

Childcare Safety Guidelines for Florida Heat: The Early Learning Coalition of Pasco and Hernando Counties is offering a 2 hour training aimed at educating early childhood educators on the importance of adopting safe behaviors and techniques for the Florida heat. This educational training includes a heatstroke safety training module. Participants will receive parent education materials to share with families. Sign up today! Prevention is the key for healthy children in the Florida heat.

Ready for Anything: What Every Child Care Center Needs to Know: This workshop will provide owners, managers and staff with the tools they need for a disaster plan. It will also provide guidance on helping children prepare for emergencies and disasters, including how to make their own "Go-Kit."

Learn What to do in an Emergency by Utilizing P.E.A.R.L.S: P.E.A.R.L.S. is the "Preschool Emergency Alert Response Learning System." It was designed specifically for early childhood centers to provide awareness of potential emergency situations such as active shooter, bomb threat, and lockdown. Learn how to respond effectively to mitigate risk and protect lives within your classrooms.

- Nutrition

It's Ok to Play with your Food: In this session, participants will learn how to use sensory play to teach children about, and expose them to, new foods. Learn how to tell the difference between a picky eater and an eating disorder, and how to make meal times fun.

- First Aid

Recognition of Communicable Diseases

Health Requirements for Infants Through School Age: Review the required immunizations for children in preschool, and how you can assist in ensuring they are protected against vaccine preventable diseases. Learn the differences between temporary medical exemption, permanent medical exemption, and religious exemption.

- Child Abuse Detection and Prevention

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QUALITY ACTIVITIES FOR INFANT AND TODDLER CARE

Provide a description of the quality activities and services the coalition provided to enhance infant and toddler care.

The Early Learning Coalition of Pasco and Hernando Counties employs an Infant and Toddler Specialist who provides on-site technical assistance and coaching to our providers. During the 2018-2019 year, our training specialists wrote and presented several trainings for infant and toddler early childhood educators. The instructional areas presented during those trainings included: infant and toddler brain development, social and emotional supports, enhancing mathematical concepts with infants and toddlers, and understanding developmental milestones for infant and toddlers. In addition, we offered four cohorts of MMCI for Infant Toddler Teachers.

MONITORING

Describe the process for monitoring of compliance with, and enforcement of, applicable state and local requirements.

All School Readiness providers are monitored for compliance according to OEL guidelines using the Statewide School Readiness Monitoring Tool. In addition, the providers must comply with state and federal statutes, Coalition policies and procedures, and term and conditions of the Statewide School Readiness Provider Contract. Providers who fail to meet compliance on the School Readiness Monitoring Tool are offered technical assistance and on-site training.

Sunshine Stars (QRIS) providers receive additional monitoring and technical support as they progress through the program. Focus areas include: staff qualification and professional development, learning environment, teacher-child interaction and family engagement.

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INCLUSION

Describe the activities the coalition has implemented to promote inclusive child care including responding to Warm-Line requests by providers and parents and providing developmental and health screenings to school readiness program children.

The Coalition has a designated staff responsible for carrying out Inclusion/Warm Line services and reporting requirements. The Developmental Services Lead participates in State conference calls, webinars, and Regional meetings, trainings and Conferences. The Coalition maintains a Warm-Line and informs Early Childhood programs of the availability of technical assistance regarding the inclusion of children with disabilities and special health care needs.

The dedicated staff provides on-site technical assistance to Providers in the areas of positive behavior supports, individualized learning plans, environmental adaptations, and assistance with referrals to community resources.

The Coalition also utilizes the Brooks Ages and Stages Developmental Screening (ASQ-3) for all children birth to five years of age for all children in the School Readiness Program within forty-five (45) days of enrollment and annually during the month of the child's birthday. If an Inclusion case is opened, the center may be asked to complete an Ages and Stages Questionnaire, Social Emotional (ASQ-SE2) in order to further assess social emotional milestones. By completing this tool, providers and parents/caregivers can quickly identify where the child is on the continuum and if there is a need for further assessment. The Developmental Services Lead, in collaboration with the Child Screening Specialist, are responsible for initiating individualized supports, including referrals for children falling below the cut-off scores on either screener.

In 2019, the Inclusion department partnered with the Substance Exposed Newborn Taskforce in both Pasco and Hernando Counties in order to share information, resources, and to create a supportive network for the families in our communities. Collectively, we compiled a comprehensive resource map, printed and distributed across the counties in health departments, doctor's offices, preschools, etc. in hopes to place needed information in the hands of our parents and providers.

Hudson Christian Life Academy changed their DBA from Little Peoples Christian Daycare (EIN 900174994) and moved locations without any verbal or written communication to the Coalition. Hudson Christian Life Academy SR Contract was executed with the Coalition on 5/1/19. Their SR Contract was initiated based on the verbal confirmation from the Owner that they have had their Department of Children and Families (DCF) Health and Safety inspection and had passed. The Coalition received communication from DCF that same day stating that the Health and Safety inspection was not completed for Hudson Christian. DCF had to return on a different date to complete their Health and Safety inspection. The Coalition immediately terminated their SR Contract as of 5/1/19. There was no SR enrollment at the time.
